



Overview of Nuance License Programs

Nuance License Programs are easy-to-use licensing options for organisations requiring as few as five licenses of Nuance software. Nuance Licenses offer cost savings, easy license management, and the ability to add licenses later through the same agreement. The cost of media, documentation, packaging, warehousing and shipping associated with boxed product are eliminated - savings which are passed onto customers. Nuance offers two License Programs – the **Nuance Site License Program** and the **Nuance Volume License Program**.

Nuance Site License Program

The Nuance Site License Program (SLP) offers medium to large size organisations substantial cost savings and a simplified license program for budget tracking. Site licenses are based on a maximum number of users within a defined site.

- A site can be a legal entity, a unit of an organisation, a department, a physical address or addresses – as nominated at time of purchase.
- Usage is permitted up to the maximum number of users in the chosen program level. Upgrade to higher level(s) is available by payment of an upgrade fee.
- A fixed price applies to each program level regardless of the number of users within that program level.
- Government and Academic pricing available to qualifying organisations.
- Dragon NaturallySpeaking licenses are based on the number of user voice profiles within a site. Note: Headsets are not included in the SLP fee. Headsets should be ordered additional to the license.
- One media kit is supplied with the order (CD/DVD, license agreement and printed user guide). Additional kits may be ordered as required.

You can use up to the maximum number of licenses in your chosen program level without the need to contact Nuance or pay additional license fees. This is convenient when hiring new employees or catering for staff changes.

The Nuance SLP provides organisations with the ability to lock in their software solution by charging a single fixed fee per program level.

4 **‘No-cost’ administration**

The Nuance Site Licensing Program eliminates tedious auditing and seat-counting requirements.

5 **Maintenance and Support available**

With optional **Maintenance and Support** you pay a single annual fee for unlimited Technical Support for 2 nominated contacts for one year. It also includes all software updates and version upgrades for one year.

Deployment rights under the Site License Program

Software may only be used at the locations listed in the license certificate. Employees of the Site who work remotely may use the software on their portable computer, home computer or as remote terminal server clients (where supported by the product).

Acquiring new licenses under a Site License Program

When you require more licenses, you simply pay an upgrade fee to move to the next level of the program. For example, if your licensed location grows when you acquire a company or the organisation wants to purchase licenses for additional locations, you pay the upgrade fee and receive a new license certificate.

Once Maintenance and Support is purchased for a product, it must also be purchased for any additional licenses.

Nuance Volume License Program

The Nuance Volume License Program (VLP) offers small to medium organisations an easy-to-use volume purchasing program to achieve cost savings on Nuance desktop solutions.

A certificate-based program, the VLP allows companies to license software rather than having to purchase retail packaged products. The savings are passed on to the customer in the form of a discount from the standard price.

- Volume Licenses can be purchased for organisations with as few as five desktops. Licenses are purchased for each individual user.
- A VLP certificate is issued for the number of licenses purchased. One media kit (CD/DVD and printed user guide) is supplied with the order.
- Customers can add new licenses for each of the Nuance VLP products if the existing VLP covers current version product.
- Optional Maintenance and Support available - pay a single annual fee for unlimited Technical Support for 2 nominated contacts plus all software updates and version upgrades for one year.
- Government and Academic pricing available to qualifying organisations.
